- Upon receipt of the required paperwork, the clerk will give you a date to appear in court. After Judicial review of the application, a fee up to \$120.00 for costs of services rendered may be imposed.
- Your application will be processed upon receipt of the forms in approximately four (4) to six (6) weeks. After Judicial review of the application, **a fee of \$57.00 for costs of services rendered may be imposed.**

A dismissal pursuant to 1203.4PC does not remove an arrest from a criminal history record. It adds a notation to the record that states: "Conviction set aside and dismissed pursuant to section 1203.4 of the California Penal Code"
