ORDER TERMINATING DEFERRED ENTRY OF JUDGMENT (PC §1000) and ENTRY OF JUDGMENT	

THE COURT FINDS that the defendant has failed to comply with the Order Granting Deferred Entry of Judgment because the defendant:

- Failed to contact the assigned program within 7 days and/or to complete enrollment within 30 days of the Order.
 - Is not performing satisfactorily in the assigned program because he or she
 - Has failed to pay program fees as directed.
 - Has accumulated unexcused absences from program activities.
 - Is not benefiting from the education, treatment or rehabilitation offered by the assigned program.
 - Has been convicted of a misdemeanor that reflects the defendant's propensity for violence.
 - Has engaged in criminal conduct rendering him or her unsuitable for deferred entry of judgment.
 - Failed to obey all laws.
 - Failed to appear in court as ordered for a review hearing.
 - Failed to pay previously ordered diversion restitution fee.
