GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the July 7, 2020 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the June 25, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Barbara County ("Court"), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Any Judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than an additional 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from July 16, 2020, through August 17, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, §68116(1)(10): Executive Order N-38-20 (03-27-20).
- 2. The Court will collaborate with local justice partners to conduct a trial at an earlier date, if a court may do so in compliance with applicable health and safety laws, regulations, and orders, including the use of remote technology.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
