The current pandemic of the novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) has resulted in the President of the United States declaring a national emergency and the Governor of California and Santa Barbara County issuing shelter-in-place orders that apply to this jurisdiction. Existing guidance from the national, state, and local public health authorities recommend social distancing of at least six feet between persons and limits gatherings to no more than 10 persons, among other preventative practices.

In response to the above issues and pursuant to section 977 of the Penal Code, inmates at the Santa Barbara County Jail may choose to appear for sentencing by two-way electronic audio-video communication.
